Attention! Final Year students, you are required to

- ✓ Design a Poster related to your BSCS Final Project.
- ✓ Prepare a Seminar Presentation related to your BSCS Final Project.

The key events with dates of this seminar are given below:

- On 16th and 17th February there will be a poster competition. The posters will be evaluated by balloting.
- From 20th February onwards you will be required to give a short seminar presentation. The presentation will be evaluated by your supervisor and two other markers.
- All the students, staff and Faculty may be invited to attend this Seminar.

Poster Competition

You must design an interactive poster describing different aspects of your project.

Seminar Presentation

The Seminar presentation is a formal presentation on the project given to project supervisor, together with any other staff or students who wish to attend. The talk should not attempt to cover all aspects of the design and implementation of the project. It should either cover the problem and general method of solution, or it should just be on a specific aspect of the project.

Guidance

The poster & seminar presentation should be aimed at the level understandable to a computer science student.

Material should preferably be organized in one of the following ways:

- A description of the general problem, the background and the general method of solution.
- A description and discussion of one aspect of the problem, rather than the project as a whole.
- A brief outline of the general problem, and a more detailed discussion of some aspect of it.
- You may include other media i.e. images, videos, and demos etc. to facilitate different aspects of your project.
